CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

TUESDAYS, 4 p.m. to 4:55 p.m.

Dino-tastic Art: Students will create dinosaurs using paint, pastels, pencils, inks, glue and papier-mache.

Funky Fashion: Great for budding designers and fashion lovers, this class gives young artists the opportunity to learn the basics of designing fashions, sewing and bringing to life their funky designs with fabric, thread and their imaginations.

WEDNESDAYS, 4 p.m. to 4:55 p.m.

Drawing Fantastic Beasts: Fairies, dragons and other fantastical beasts already "in existence" will be the subject of students' first drawings. They will then develop the idea for and draw their own fantastic beasts.

Draw Your Fantasy: Students will learn to draw and develop fantasy characters and fantasy worlds.

Mixed-Media Painting: Students will have the opportunity to explore various art materials to create one-of-a-kind art pieces. Each piece students make will be made using a minimum of 3 different art media. They will create works from imagination and move on to creating works from observation. The overall purpose of

this class is for students to explore multiple ways of adding color and texture to an art piece by using more than one material. They will learn about what materials work well together, and also about color, patterns, balance, texture, and general fundamentals of art.

Traditional Acrylic Painting: In this class, students will be working from observation. Each session will start with a fast-drawing warm up. Students will then move on to painting a still life. They will be taught about color, how to mix colors, composition, balance and the overall fundamentals of art.
