### OVERVIEW:

Three, weeklong sessions run from July 9-13, July 16-20, and July 23-27. All classes are Monday through Friday, with classes scheduled from 10 a.m.-11:50 a.m., 12:30 p.m.-2:20 p.m. and 2:30 p.m.-4:20 p.m. Supervised lunch is available from 11:50 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

The registration fee for each class is \$75, or \$225 if a student registers for three classes during one session. Scholarships are available, and discounts may be applied if two or more siblings register for classes or a single student for multiple classes. All class supplies are provided and included in the registration fees.

## CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

### Session 1

**Acting Shakespeare:** Students will have the opportunity to deconstruct, memorize and perform short scenes and monologues by the famous bard as well as the history of some of Shakespeare's most famous plays.

**Fun with Watercolor!:** Learn techniques used by watercolor artists to create beautiful, colorful, realistic and experimental results.

**Drawing Anime:** Learn the basics of anime drawing, focusing on facial characteristics and expressions. We will be using colored pencil, permanent ink pen and watercolor.

**Mixed Media Portraits and Figures:** Students will start this class with mixed media drawings before building up to collage work and wrapping up the week with sculpting.

**Scenes and Prop Design:** Students will learn the basics of scenic painting for the stage including brick walls, splatter painting, marbleizing and scumbling. They will also learn to make props including fake food and crowns.

**Drawing Mythical Creatures:** Fairies, dragons and other mythical creatures already "in existence" will be the subject of students' first drawings. They will then develop the idea for and draw their own mythical creature.

**Color My World!:** A color mixing extravaganza - learn how to mix colors to achieve desired results - whether natural, impressionistic or experimental. We will be working with oil pastels, tempera paint and acrylic paint.
