These classes combine elements of writing, improv, and acting in fun and unexpected ways, providing students with an opportunity to turn thoughts into entertainment while finding a unique way to express their ideas. Storytelling is an enjoyable and engaging way for students to discover their creativity and gain the confidence to share it.

Short Form Storytelling (July 9 – 13) will focus on taking existing stories and adapting them in a way that is unique to the individual. Students will learn how to create and perform a 3 – 5 minute story which they will perform at a public showcase. It's a great way for young, creative minds to make a well-known story their own.
